Overview of the Plan for the Sapporo Daibiru Building Redevelopment Project

DAIBIRU CORPORATION (Head Office: Kita-ku, Osaka; Representative Director, President Chief Executive Officer: Takashi Maruyama) released an overview of its plan for the Sapporo Daibiru Building Redevelopment Project currently underway in Sapporo City, Hokkaido Prefecture, during a press conference held October 6, 2023.

One of the core functions of the completed project will be hotel services. Therefore, we would like to announce the decision to establish TRUNK (HOTEL) SAPPORO (tentative name), a luxury boutique hotel, as part of this project. TRUNK (HOTEL) SAPPORO will be managed by TAKE and GIVE NEEDS Co., Ltd. (Head Office: Higashi-Shinagawa, Shinagawa-ku; President and Representative Director: Kenji Iwase).

October 9, 2023, will mark the 100th anniversary of Daibiru and over this time we have expanded in Japan from Osaka, to Tokyo, to our third city, Sapporo. In 2019, our company acquired three properties, including PIVOT, a long-adored fixture for the people of Sapporo, and established the Sapporo Project Office, which is now the Sapporo Project Department. After active communication with Sapporo City and the local community, we have followed this up with a plan for a redevelopment project. This plan involves the construction of a mixed-use building that consists of a section for offices, a hotel, and shops, making optimal use of its location, where business and commercial areas converge.

We selected a TRUNK (HOTEL) brand hotel for this project, fulfilling one of the project's core functions. TRUNK (HOTEL) is a brand of luxury boutique hotels managed by TAKE and GIVE NEEDS, which operates Japan's largest wedding business. The first TRUNK (HOTEL) opened in 2017, in Jingumae, Tokyo, and the second opened in September 2023 in Yoyogi Park, Tokyo. The hotel established as part of this project will be the first TRUNK (HOTEL) in Hokkaido Prefecture.

Construction of the property is scheduled to be completed at the end of January 2027 and opening of the hotel is scheduled for Spring 2027.


