Social Contribution Activities in Vietnam

Since 2017, DAIBIRU CORPORATION (Head office: Kita-ku, Osaka; Representative Director, President Chief Executive Officer: Takashi Maruyama) has engaged in a variety of social contribution activities in Vietnam through its operating companies (local subsidiaries) in the country.

Recently, Daibiru CSB Co., Ltd. a local subsidiary based in Hanoi, Vietnam, donated picture books and other items to three kindergartens located in the mountainous areas of Vietnam's Hoa Binh Province. The company has also held reading activities at these locations.

In addition, Daibiru Saigon Tower Co., Ltd. a local subsidiary based in Ho Chi Minh City, has made donations to Hoa Binh Village, a support facility for orphans and children with physical disabilities, and the Sustainable Community Development Fund, which plants mangroves. The activities of both local subsidiaries are outlined below.

Description: Donation of picture books via general incorporated association Hashi wo Kakeru

Recipients: Three kindergartens in the village of Muong Chien of Hoa Binh Province,

Date of donation: November 11, 2023

Vision: The village of Muong Chien is located in a mountainous region of Vietnam, and

most of its residents are ethnic minorities. These residents face hardships due to underdeveloped transportation and infrastructure. In mountainous regions, it can be difficult to send children to school, making it difficult for them to receive exposure to books and reading instruction. Daibiru CSB is therefore conducting activities to help deliver books to children in this region to cultivate an interest in reading and to make reading a regular part of their lives. By doing so, Daibiru

CSB hopes to bring them closer to achieving their dreams.

1) Recipient: Hoa Binh Village*2

Date of donation: September 14, 2023

Vision: Vietnam still has many vulnerable people who require medical and financial

assistance, and Hoa Binh Village was established to support them. This donation was provided with the hope of bringing smiles and enjoyment to those utilizing

the facility.

2) Recipient: Sustainable Community Development Fund*3

Date of donation: December 21, 2023

Vision: The donation was made to support local mangrove planting activities with the

hope of aiding Soc Trang Province (an area in the Mekong Delta region located southwest of Ho Chi Minh City), where damage to crops and human lives has been ongoing due to the lack of mangroves serving as windbreaks and breakwaters. In addition to preventing the damage mentioned above, this tree-planting initiative is expected to help purify shrimp farming wastewater and significantly reduce greenhouse gas emissions, since mangroves absorb

approximately twice as much CO2 than a typical forest.

Daibiru owns and operates the CornerStone Building and Saigon Tower, which are both A-grade office buildings in Vietnam, through Daibiru CSB and Daibiru Saigon Tower, respectively. Furthermore, in December 2023, Daibiru acquired a major equity interest in 63 Ly Thai To, an A-grade office/commercial building located in Hoan Kiem District, the central business district (CBD) of Hanoi, Vietnam. Another office building with 16 floors above ground and 2 floors below ground is under development in the Starlake district, located on the western side of West Lake, approximately six kilometers from the Hanoi CBD.

Daibiru will continue to expand its business in Vietnam and actively engage in social contribution activities in the country.
